RE: Snow Plowing in Kittatinny Lake

Dear Jeff:

In preparation for the winter, and in an effort to safely do our job regarding snow plowing within Kittatinny Lake, we wish to remind and advise residents of Kittatinny Lake of our standing procedure.

As you are aware, we have discussed on several occasions the problems our Road Foreman has had with vehicles around Kittatinny Lake which are illegally parked and blocking the roadway. There are vehicles parked illegally in areas not meant for parking and vehicles which are parked haphazardly on the side of the roads too close to the roadway where our snow plow cannot safely maneuver without risking vehicle and property damage. As snow accumulates, it becomes more and more difficult to not only plow, but to find places to safely push the snow.

Therefore, please allow this letter to serve as our notice to the Kittatinny Lake Club, Inc and residents, that should our Road Department Foreman feel he cannot safely plow the roads due to vehicles parked illegally, dangerously or blocking the road he will cease plowing the road until the vehicles are moved. He will notify you directly of this situation and await word from you that the vehicles have been moved to a better location and continue to plow.
